

Terms and Conditions for the Digital Product – “School of God’s Leaders – SBL” Online Course

[Last updated: 14 May 2026]

§1. General Provisions

1. These Terms and Conditions set out the rules for the purchase and use of the digital product in the form of the biblical course “School of God’s Leaders – SBL” online (hereinafter: the “SBL Course”) made available through the mobile application and related electronic services operated by Glory Church, a local church in Warsaw, with its registered office at ul. Skibicka 5, 02-269 Warsaw, entered into the Register of Churches and Other Religious Associations in Section A under item 157 on 10 October 2003 (hereinafter: the “Service Provider”).
2. These Terms and Conditions constitute a set of rules governing the provision of electronic services within the meaning of the Act of 18 July 2002 on the Provision of Electronic Services and define the rights and obligations of the Service Provider and users acting as consumers.
3. For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions, the Service Provider provides the following contact details (means of communication):

4. The SBL Course constitutes digital content within the meaning of the Consumer Rights Act, supplied to the user in a non-material form via the Application.
5. The User may not use the Application or the SBL Course, including placing Orders, anonymously, under a pseudonym, or using incorrect personal data.
6. The User is obliged to use the SBL Course in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, applicable laws, and accepted standards of conduct, while respecting personal rights and intellectual property rights, in particular copyrights held by the Service Provider or third parties, and in a manner that does not disrupt the operation of the SBL Course or the Application.
7. The use of the SBL Course is conditional upon acceptance of these Terms and Conditions, the Application Terms and Conditions, and the Privacy Policy.

§2. Definitions

1. “SBL Course” means paid digital content including educational materials in the form of audio recordings, video recordings, supplementary materials, and other content

made available electronically by Glory Church. All Content made available as part of the SBL Course remains the property of Glory Church or the entities holding rights to such Content. The User does not acquire ownership rights to the Content or any economic copyrights but only gains access to the SBL Course under an end-user license.

2. "Application" means the Glory Church mobile application.
3. "User" means a natural person holding an account in the Application who has purchased the SBL Course.
4. "Consumer" means a natural person performing a legal act not directly related to their business or professional activity.
5. "Content" means all materials made available within the SBL Course, regardless of their form.
6. "Agreement for the supply of digital content through granting access under an end-user license" means an agreement granting a non-exclusive license providing access to the SBL Course, concluded or entered into between the Consumer and the Service Provider through the Application, under which the Service Provider undertakes to provide the Consumer with access to the SBL Course and the Consumer undertakes to pay the Service Provider the license fee for access to the SBL Course.

§3. Technical Requirements

1. In order to properly use the SBL Course, it is necessary to:
 - a) possess a mobile device with Internet access;
 - b) install the current version of the Application;
 - c) use a compatible Android or iOS operating system supported by the Application provider;
 - d) have an active User account in the Application;
 - e) maintain an active Internet connection enabling the playback of digital Content.

The Service Provider recommends using the latest operating system versions and Application updates to ensure proper functioning of the SBL Course.

The Service Provider shall not be liable for improper functioning of the SBL Course resulting from the User's failure to meet the minimum technical requirements referred to in this section.

Deleting the User's account in the Application or on the Glory Church website shall result in loss of access to the SBL Course granted under the end-user license.

§4. Conclusion of the Agreement for the Supply of Digital Content through Granting Access under an End-User License

1. The agreement for the supply of digital content through granting access under an end-user license is concluded upon successful payment by the User and receipt of confirmation of the granting of the non-exclusive license.
2. Access to the SBL Course may be granted immediately after the payment is credited.
3. The Service Provider enables payments through external payment service providers, including Stripe, PayU, and Przelewy24.
4. The User is obliged to provide truthful and up-to-date information necessary for order fulfillment.

§5. Access to the SBL Course

1. The SBL Course is made available exclusively to the User who has acquired the end-user license and created an account in the Application.
2. Access to the SBL Course is personal and assigned exclusively to the User account created in the Glory Church Application or on the Glory Church website.
3. After deleting the account, the User loses access to the SBL Course.
4. Restoration of access to the SBL Course is possible upon the User's request submitted to the administrator.
5. After deletion of the User account, the content of messages published by the User shall remain visible; however, data identifying the User, in particular their name and surname, shall be removed.
6. The Service Provider reserves the right to temporary technical interruptions related to maintenance, updates, or development of the technical infrastructure.
7. The Service Provider does not guarantee uninterrupted and error-free access to the SBL Course but undertakes to take actions aimed at ensuring the proper operation of the service.

§6. Price

1. The price displayed in the Application is expressed in Polish zloty (PLN). The Service Provider benefits from VAT exemption.
2. The price of the SBL Course constitutes a one-time fee and grants the User access to the SBL Course for the duration of maintaining the User account in the Application and while the SBL Course remains available as part of the Service Provider's activities.

3. Information regarding the SBL Course, in particular its content, price, payment methods, and type of access, is presented in the Application within the description of the SBL Course.
4. The Service Provider reserves the right to change the price of the SBL Course and other Content presented in the Application, withdraw Content, and introduce new Content. The above right shall not affect orders placed before the effective date of the price change.

§7. Copyright and License

1. All intellectual property rights, including economic copyrights to the SBL Course and all Content made available within it, belong exclusively to Glory Church or the relevant third parties.
2. The SBL Course constitutes a work protected under the Copyright and Related Rights Act.
3. Upon gaining access to the SBL Course, the User is granted a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, and non-assignable end-user license authorizing use of the SBL Course solely for personal use through:
 - a) the Account in the Application,
 - b) the Account on the Glory Church website.
4. The User is not authorized to grant sublicenses, transfer rights arising from the license, or provide access to the SBL Course to third parties.

The license does not authorize the User to:

- a) copy, record, or reproduce the Content beyond permitted personal use;
 - b) publicly share the Content;
 - c) distribute, resell, sublicense, or provide access to third parties;
 - d) publish the Content on the Internet, social media, or other communication channels;
 - e) use the SBL Course for commercial or training purposes without prior written consent of the Service Provider.
5. Violation of the license terms may result in immediate blocking of access to the SBL Course and pursuit by Glory Church of claims provided for under applicable law.

§8. No Right of Withdrawal

1. The User acting as a consumer acknowledges that pursuant to Article 38(1)(13) of the Consumer Rights Act, they lose the right to withdraw from the agreement for the

supply of digital content not supplied on a tangible medium if performance has begun with their express prior consent before the expiry of the withdrawal period.

2. Before making a purchase, the User consents to the commencement of the service consisting of immediate granting of access to the SBL Course and the Content made available under the non-exclusive end-user license before the expiry of the withdrawal period.
3. The User confirms acknowledgment that upon commencement of performance in accordance with section 2, they lose the right to withdraw from the agreement.
4. The consent referred to in sections 2–3 is granted by selecting the appropriate checkbox before completing the purchase.

§9. Complaints

1. The User has the right to submit a complaint regarding the functioning of the SBL Course or non-conformity of the digital Content with the agreement.
2. Complaints should be submitted electronically to: office@kosciolchwaly.pl.
3. The complaint should contain information enabling identification of the User and a description of the reported problem.
4. The Service Provider shall examine the complaint within 14 days from the date of receipt.

§10. Liability

1. The Service Provider shall be liable for conformity of the digital Content with the agreement to the extent provided for by applicable law.
2. The Service Provider shall not be liable for:
 - a) inability to use the SBL Course resulting from reasons attributable to the User;
 - b) improper operation of the User's device or software;
 - c) consequences of the User sharing login credentials with third parties.
3. The User is obliged to secure account access data against unauthorized access.

§11. Personal Data

1. Users' personal data are processed in accordance with applicable law and the Privacy Policy.
2. Detailed information regarding the processing of personal data is contained in a separate document – the Privacy Policy.

§12. Final Provisions

1. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by Polish law.
2. In matters not regulated herein, the provisions of the following shall apply:
 - a) the Civil Code;
 - b) the Consumer Rights Act;
 - c) the Act on the Provision of Electronic Services;
 - d) the Copyright and Related Rights Act.
3. The Service Provider reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions for important reasons, in particular in the event of:
 - a) changes in legal regulations;
 - b) technological or functional changes to the Application;
 - c) expansion or modification of the scope of services provided;
 - d) the need to adapt the Terms and Conditions to decisions of administrative authorities or court rulings.
4. Users shall be informed of amendments to the Terms and Conditions sufficiently in advance via the Application or e-mail.
5. Any disputes shall be resolved by competent common courts in accordance with applicable law.
